In what follows, we present our general observations and suggestions for navigating intellectual capital after the financial crisis in three sections. The first section describes our findings by drawing connections between national intellectual capital (NIC) and macroeconomic indicators, such as Global Competitiveness Index (GCI, published by the World Economic Forum annually) and GDP per capita (ppp).

Navigating Intellectual Capital After the Financial Crisis

The most widely used definition of intellectual capital is “knowledge that is of value to an organization.” Its main elements are human capital, structural capital, and customer capital. That definition suggests that the management of knowledge (the sum of what is known) creates intellectual capital⁵.
