In a survey of 24 countries, England, Wales and Northern Ireland had the lowest levels of participation in upper secondary mathematics. They were the only countries in which fewer than 20% of upper secondary students study maths. This includes all mathematics qualifications at this level, but excludes GCSE retakes.
