Context- King Lear. Written in 1606 and set in the same period, Shakespeare wrote a play influenced by society around him. Beliefs at the time were strongly influenced by the chain of being- this means God has a plan for everyone and where they are on the chain: breaking from this chain and therefore straying from God's path had catastrophic results.
